
The KINK by Doc Johnson[®] PUMPED Rechargeable Automatic Vibrating Pussy Pump can be used with both the suction and vibration features enabled, or either feature separately.

TO OPERATE PUMP:

- Apply water-based lubricant to the silicone rim of the pump that meets the skin; this will help form a seal and create suction. (fig. a)
- Gently press and hold the transparent cup to the preferred area. (fig. b)
- Press to power on the pump's automatic suction and choose a suction speed. Within a few seconds, enough suction should form to keep the pumping chamber in place without holding it.
- If vibration is desired, this is the optimal time to power on and select one of the pump's 7 vibrating functions. (see other side for instructions)
- Watch for the pumped area to begin swelling.
 The recipient will also be able to feel the enlarging effects.
- When the area is visibly swollen or when the recipient is ready to stop, press and hold the air-release button, gently remove the pump, and press to power off suction.
- Use extra lubricant for sex or masturbation after pumping.



TO OPERATE VIBRATING FUNCTIONS:

- Press (M) to power on vibration.
- Press (M) to cycle through the 7 different vibration modes.
- Press and hold (M) to power off vibration.

TO LOCK/UNLOCK:

- Press and hold o to lock the pump from powering on during travel or storage.
- To unlock, press and hold (M) (O) or plug into charger.

TO CHARGE:

- Connect cable to small port on lower back of pump handle.
- Plug USB end into any device or charger with a USB port.
- Pump fully charges in 90 minutes. (Usage time: 60 minutes)

CAUTION: Do not overpump. If any pain or discomfort is experienced during use, stop pumping immediately, press the air-release button, and seek medical attention as needed. Users with known medical conditions should consult a physician before use. Play responsibly.
